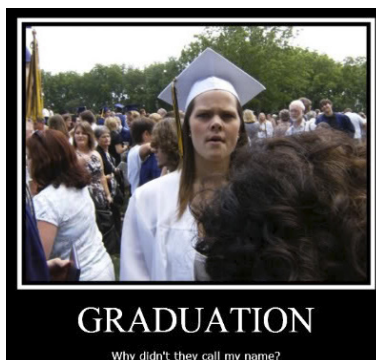


## MSUM Fall Commencement

- >If they have questions, don't be shy! We love providing correct information so the commencement day flows smoothly and everyone has a fantastic time.



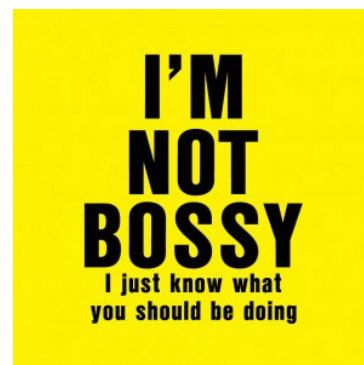
## Veterans Benefits

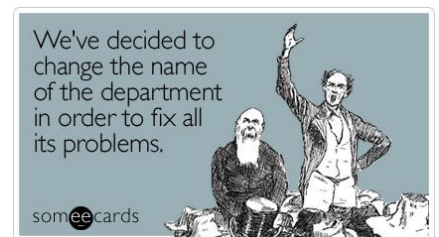
