Following the game, a dance in the high school auditorium climaxed the evening's homecoming festivities.








The MS high baseball team enjoyed a good season in 1951. They won the LVC for the third straight year. Their seasons record was 5-2.


MS lost three starters from last years team. There are ten letterman returning to bolster this years team. They will have a vetern infield with Roger Hegland doing most of the pitching.


