First, we direct that all our just debts and funeral expenses be left to the Junior Class.

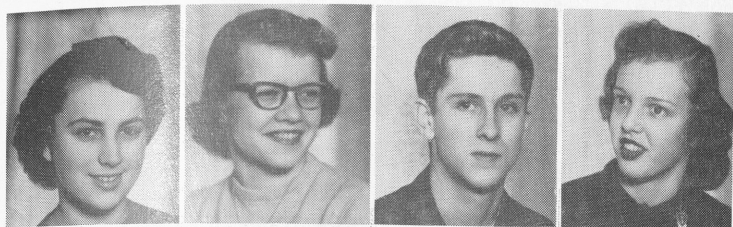

The ceremonies ended with the audience singing the school song, "College High School," which put everyone in high spirits for the game that followed.

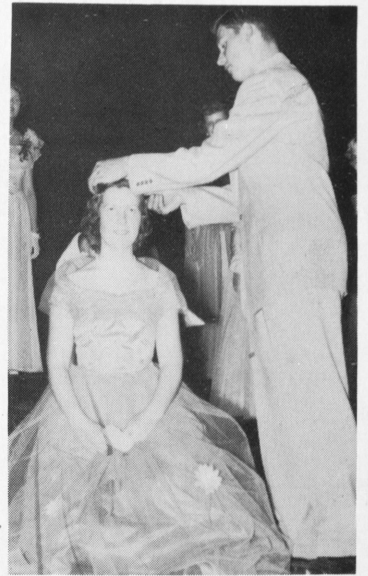
The Baby Dragons emerged victorious over the Felton Tigers.
