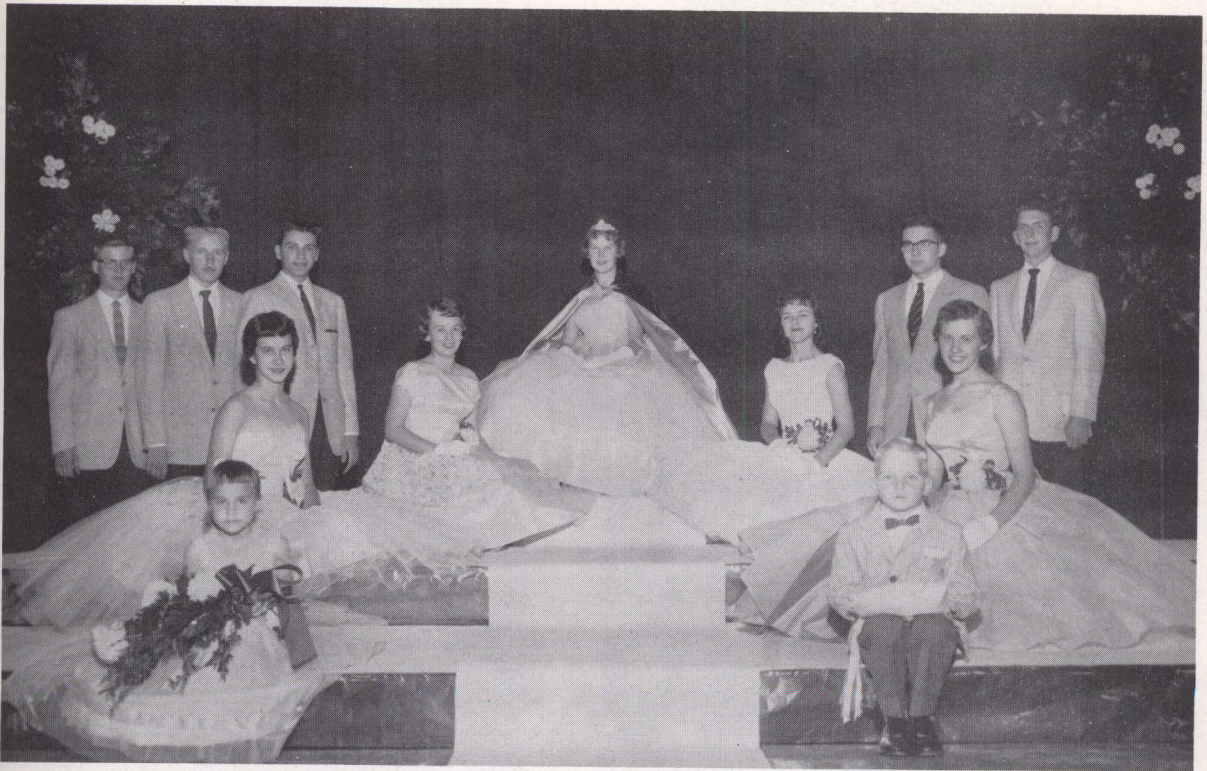

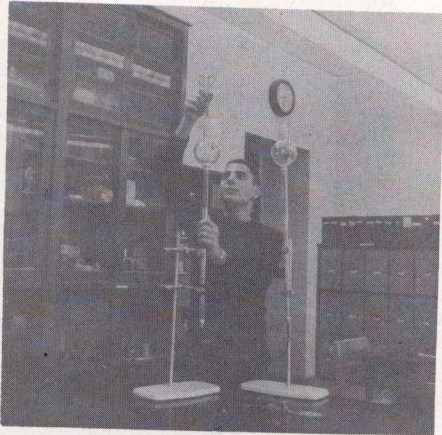

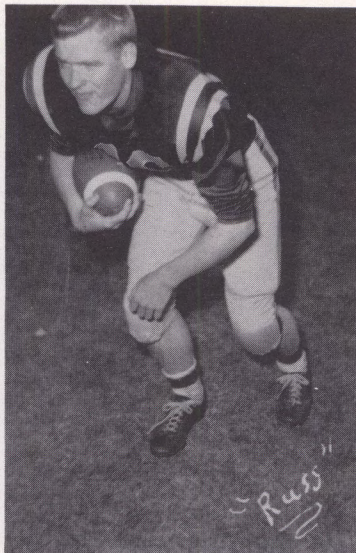

Leading scorers were Donald Jones, 70 points; Russell Krabbenhoft, 48 points; and Dave Bergford, 30 points.

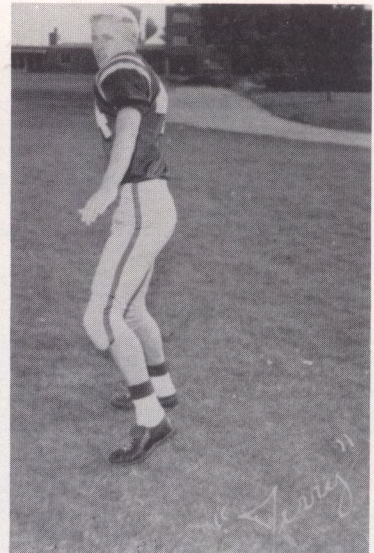

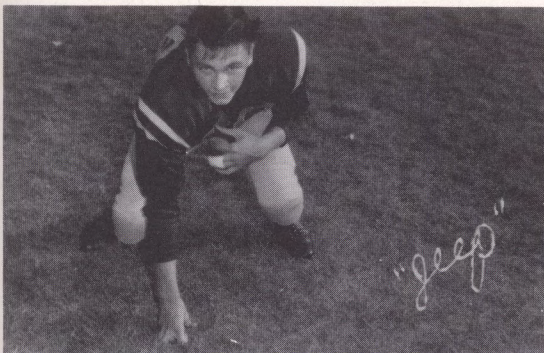

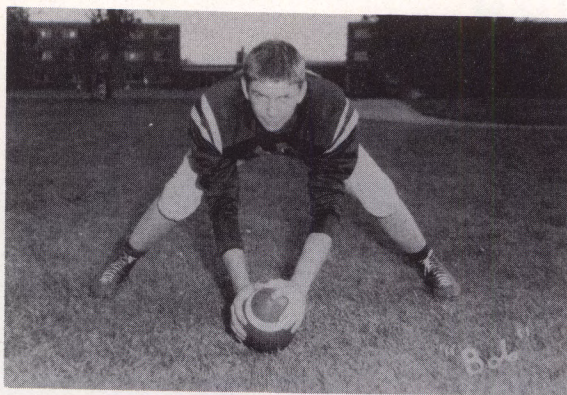
