The Administrative Academic Council has recommended approval of the Topical Term proposal presented at the February 12 APAC meeting with the following conditions:

1. Title be changed to indicate the hypothetical character of some of the constructs;
2. Proposal be reviewed and changed as necessary so that the proposal is consistent with the new title;
3. That the four courses be presented as new courses and be subject to the new course proposal route.

Minor Curriculum Revisions

The following minor curriculum revisions were approved:

- Change in number from Economics 290 to Economics 390

MCS 315, Afro-American Music

Social Work 311

Biology 309, 360(g)

D. Corrick moved, A. Mudgett seconded, to approve Biology 309, Principles of Hematology, 3 cr. and Biology 360(g), Pathogenic Microbiology, 4 cr. Motion carried.

Proposed Grading System

Discussion was held on whether it was desirable to have more options in the grading system than what is currently available. Council members indicated they would discuss this with their departments and this item will be placed on the agenda again if there is interest expressed by a faculty member or department.
