Minor Curriculum Revisions

The following minor curriculum revisions were approved:

Add prerequisite of Accounting 332 to the following courses:
Acct 430(g), 431(g), 450(g), 460(g), 470(g), 480(g), ~~440(g)~~

Change in title of Acct 430(g), from Advanced Acct I to Consolidations

Change in title of Acct 431(g), from Advanced Acct II to Advanced Topics

Drop Acct 410(g) as an alternative prerequisite for Acct 451(g)

Revisions in Mass Communications Program

Recommended change in policy on overloads
