Minor Curriculum Revisions

The following minor curriculum revisions were approved:

Change the related field requirement for the B.S. in Mathematics from ComS 150 to: One of the following courses:

ComS 130 BASIC (3), ComS 140 FORTRAN (4), or ComS 201 PASCAL (4).

Require the following related field requirement for the B.A. degree in Mathematics: One of the following courses:

ComS 140 FORTRAN (4), or

ComS 201 PASCAL (4).

Approval of LA designation (Social Science) for Political Science 353, Politics of Latin American Countries (4).

LART 314

E. Clark moved, L. Chua seconded, to approve LART 314, American Literature and the Great Depression (4). Motion carried.

LART 316

W. Harri moved, D. Cole seconded, to approve LART 316, Democratic Theory and Practice: A Global View (4). Motion carried.
