#### APAC Policy Manual

The APAC policy manual was discussed. No revisions were made.

J. Stevens requested that the procedures for reviewing the Liberal Arts program revisions be prepared and given to APAC.

#### Master of Arts in Music

The proposal for the Master of Arts in Music was discussed.

#### MLA 505 and 510

- S. Roy moved, J. Stevens seconded, to approve MLA 505, Integration Seminar I (2) and MLA 510, Integration Seminar II (2) with the stipulation that 505 be listed as a prerequisite for 510.
- S. Roy moved, R. Bolton seconded, to amend the motion by adding that MLA 501, 502 and 503 will be dropped effective Fall, 1987. Motion to amend carried. Motion to approve as amended carried.

### Proposal for Major in Liberal Arts

S. Roy moved, R. Bolton seconded, to have a subcommittee review the proposal for a Major in Liberal Arts and report back to APAC regarding the title, content, and where the major would be housed. Motion carried 6-5.
