APAC Minutes
March 29, 1988

Members Present: F. C. Richardson, Chair; E. Alberts, D. Fetting, Margaret Moore, T. Schaum, J. Snyder, L. Thalman, W. Vollmers, B. Wasson, K. Wise

Revision in Chemistry Major

T. Schaum moved, W. Vollmers seconded, to approve the revisions in the Chemistry Major. Motion carried.

Individualized Major

E. Alberts moved, T. Schaum seconded, to approve the proposed changes in the Individualized Major requirements.

W. Vollmers moved, T. Schaum seconded, to amend the motion to require at least 15 credits in the 30-credit area of concentration and a minimum of 40 credits of the 192 at the 300 and 400 level. Motion to amend carried.

The motion as amended:

1. That the requirements for the individualized major be changed as follows:

"30 of the 70 credits in the major must be at the 300 and 400 level; at least 15 of these upper level credits must be in the 30-credit area of concentration," and a minimum of 40 credits of the 192 required for graduation must be at the 300 and 400 level.
2. That no more than 4 credits of internship may be included in the 70 credits required for the major.

Motion as amended carried with one abstention.
