Multidisciplinary Studies

Molly Moore moved, L. Bakke seconded, to approve the name change for MDS 110, Developmental Writing, to Expressive Writing. Motion carried unanimously.

Art

D. Scott moved, T. Schaum seconded, to approve an increase in credits from 3 to 4 for Art 270, Art Appreciation. Motion carried unanimously.

Speech/Language/Hearing Sciences

Molly Moore moved, Margaret Moore seconded, to approve an increase in credits from 3 to 4 for SLPA 501, Research in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology. Motion carried unanimously.

Individualized Major

Discussion suspended until the next meeting.

Psychology

E. Alberts moved, D. Scott seconded, to approve the following change in the requirements for the M.S. degree in School Psychology:

The current M.S. degree requirement for "one elective" should be changed to require a course in the biological bases of behavior. Psy 445g: Physiological Psychology would satisfy this requirement.

Motion carried unanimously.

Business Education

D. Scott moved, Margaret Moore seconded, to increase the number of liberal arts credits from 42 to 45 for all A.S. degrees in Medical Records Technology. Motion carried unanimously.

Philosophy

D. Scott moved, T. Schaum seconded, to approve Philosophy 210, Musical Aesthetics (4) including LA designation--Division D. Motion carried unanimously.

Molly Moore moved, E. Alberts seconded, that Philosophy 210, Business Ethics (4) will not have Liberal Arts designation. Motion carried 7-1.
