Mathematics

- 2. E. Alberts moved, L. Bakke seconded, to change from 3 to the 3-4 variable credit option the following six courses:

  - 2. Pol 321 The American Presidency
  - 3. Pol 324 American Political Parties
  - 4. Pol 341(g) Public Policy
  - 5. Pol 352(g) Political Problems in Developing Countries
  - 6. Pol 420(g) Seminar in American Politics
