Business Administration

Unanimously approved changing course number of Senior Seminar in Management from Mgmt 471 to Mgmt 480.

Social Studies

E. Alberts moved, P. Beare seconded, to approve the revised social studies teaching major proposal.

M. Hansel moved, C. Brown seconded, to amend the original motion and add the following statement to the description of the major:

In the major there must be a minimum of 36 credits upper division work. (Out of the 95 credits at least 36 credits be upper level.)

Amended motion defeated 4-5.

Original motion carried 6-2-2.

Multicultural Studies Revisions

J. Snyder moved, M. Hansel seconded, to approve the revisions in the American Indian Studies minor. Motion carried unanimously.

Multicultural Studies 225

M. Hansel moved, D. Scott seconded, to approve MCS 225, Ojibwe Culture (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Margaret Moore moved, D. Scott seconded, to approve LA designation, Humanities, for MCS 225, Ojibwe Culture.

D. Scott moved, P. Beare seconded, to approve an amended motion to free the course from a provision specifying that a certain instructor teach the course in order to have a "Humanities" designation. Amended motion for LA designation in Division D, Humanities, passed unanimously.

Multicultural Studies 300

Unanimously approved LA designation, Division D, Humanities, for MCS 300, Topics in Multicultural Studies, "World View of African American Exiles".

E. Alberts moved, Margaret Moore seconded, to approve HMR 300, Introduction to Foodservice (2 or 3). Motion carried unanimously.

HMR 443, Beverage Management and requirement of HMR 349, Foodservice Laboratory, will be placed on the next meeting agenda.

Biology 105

D. Scott moved, M. Hansel seconded, to approve Biology 105, Exploring Biology (4). Motion carried unanimously.

M. Hansel moved, D. Scott seconded, to approve LA designation for Biology 105 with the following addition: To not allocate seats for any particular major. Motion defeated 2-6.

Motion to approve LA designation, Division B, Natural Sciences, for Biology 105 passed unanimously.
