Health Curriculum

Bakke moved, Alvarez seconded, to approve the minor revisions in the Health Curriculum. Motion carried unanimously.

PE 312

DeMaio moved, Bakke seconded, to approve PE 312, Social/Psychological Aspects of Sport and Exercise (3). Motion carried unanimously.

Early Childhood Education

Moore moved, Brown seconded, to approve changing the name of the Early and Exceptional Education major and minor to Early Childhood Education. Motion carried unanimously.

Moore moved, Bakke seconded, to approve the Child Growth and Development, Alternative for Elementary and Early Childhood Majors. Motion carried 8-2. This major will not be advertised as a degree tract; it will be an alternative for students who do not complete student teaching.

Humanities & MCS

Gracyk moved, Bring seconded, to approve AMST 201, American Cultural Origins (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Gracyk moved, Brown seconded, to approve AMST 202, Multicultural America Comes of Age (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Gracyk moved, Brown seconded, to approve AMST 203, Modern Multicultural America (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Gracyk moved, DeMaio seconded, to approve MCS 210, 20th Century African American Humanities (4). Moore moved, Bakke seconded, to table MCS 210 until complete materials are submitted. Motion to table carried with one abstention. It was noted that the course abbreviation will need to be shortened.

Gracyk moved, Bakke seconded, to approve MCS 332, Indians of the Southwest (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Gracyk moved, Bakke seconded, to approve HUM 333, Love in the West (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Action on the proposed revisions in the Afro-American Studies Minor was postponed.
