- Psy 532, Advanced Psychological Methodology (3)
- Psy 623, Assessment/Intervention III: Early Childhood Handicaps (4)
- Psy 624, Assessment/Intervention IV: Psychosocial Problems (5)
- SpEd 520, Perspectives and Policies in Special Education (3)

Motion carried unanimously.

History 350

Gracyk moved, Zarrett seconded, to approve History 350, Women in European History (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Gracyk moved, DeMaio seconded, that the Women's Studies curriculum be amended to include History 350 as part of its core curriculum, not in addition to the present core courses, but as an alternative to History 375 or English 246. Motion carried unanimously.

English 300
