Physics

Moore moved, Bakke seconded, to approve the changes in Physics 101 from 3 to 4 credit hours and to drop Physics 101L. Motion carried unanimously.

Moore moved, Walker seconded, to approve the following changes in credits for Physics 330, from 3 to 4 and Physics 331, from 3 to 2. Motion carried unanimously.

Mass Communications

DeMaio moved, Brown seconded, to table the proposed changes until a new course proposal is submitted. Motion to table carried.

Associate Degree

Bring moved, Bakke seconded, to approve MSU offering a single associate degree, the Associate of Arts, and that the requirements for the A.A. be changed to conform with the new Liberal Studies lower division requirements. Motion carried unanimously.

Walker moved, Moore seconded, to approve the proposed policy on registration during final quarter at MSU for Graduate Students (attached). Motion carried 6-4.

Music

Walker moved, Bakke seconded, to approve Music 120, Introduction to Music Industry (1). Motion carried unanimously.

Moore moved, Brown seconded, to table revisions in the Music Industry Program and Music 425, Current Trends in the Music Industry (3). Motion to table carried.
