Philosophy 445(g)

Gracyk moved, McGahey seconded, to approve Phil 445(g), Topics in Feminist Theory (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Indirect Cost Earnings

Gracyk moved, Brown seconded, to approve the policy on Indirect Cost Earnings.

Beare moved, Gracyk seconded, to amend as follows: earnings not specified by the grant be split 50:50. Motion to amend carried.

Walker moved, McGahey seconded, to amend the proposed policy as follows: It is the policy of MSU that indirect cost earnings not specified by the grant shall be used for institutional support in seeking external funds and conducting externally funded scholarly work. The "institutional" portion of the indirect cost earnings from grants and contracts awarded to faculty will be disbursed at the discretion of the Vice President of Academic Affairs in consultation with the President. Amendment carried. Motion as amended carried unanimously.

Business Administration

Gracyk moved, Zarrett seconded, to drop Speech 202, 219, 221, and 310 as Business Administration Speech requirements. Motion carried unanimously.
