APAC Minutes May 4, 1993

IndS 482

Alberts moved, Moore seconded, to approve the change in title for Industrial Studies 482 to Quality Planning and Implementation. Motion carried.

IndS 245, 346, 446

Moore moved, Engels seconded, to approve IndS 245, Introduction to Industrial Distribution (2); IndS 346, Industrial Distribution Operations (2); IndS 446, ID Quality Programs (2). Motion carried unanimously.

SLHS Revisions 446

McGahey moved, DeMaio seconded, to approve the revision in SLHS 446. Gracyk moved, Engels seconded, to table. Motion to table carried.

CIS 151, 152, 153

Moore moved, Gracyk seconded, to approve CIS 151, Introduction to Spreadsheets: Lotus (2); CIS 152, Introduction to Database: dBase (2); CIS 153, Introduction to Word Processing: Word Perfect (2). Motion carried with one opposed and one abstention.

Math Curriculum Revisions

Alberts moved, Peil seconded, to approve the Math Curriculum revisions. Motion carried unanimously.

Math 204

Moore moved, Engels seconded, to approve Math 204, Informal Geometry (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Capstone Experience for English Majors

Engels moved, McGahey seconded, to approve the proposal for a Capstone Experience for senior-level English majors. Motion carried unanimously.

Economics Major

Gracyk moved, Alberts seconded, to approve the following Speech requirement for Economics majors: all Economics majors are required to take one of the following courses: Speech 100, 204, 210 or 312. Motion carried unanimously.

Chemistry Curriculum Revisions

Alberts moved, McGahey seconded, to approve the revisions in the Chemistry Curriculum. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>CRJS 433</u>

Moore moved, Engels seconded, to approve CRJS 433, Police Report Writing (4). Motion carried unanimously.

Revisions in CJ Major

Moore moved, Olday seconded, to approve the revisions in the CJ major:

- (a) Sophmore status and 2.00 GPA for admission to the major and to secure a Criminal Justice advisor.
- (b) Drop the requirement of two multicultural studies courses.
- (c) Change the tool requirement to a methods requirement in which students complete a two course (minimum) methods sequence in the area of concentration or in Legal Assistance.

Motion carried unanimously.
