APAC Minutes October 5, 1993

Moorhead State University Assessment Plan.

Dean Strong and Counseling Center Director Cliff Schuette reported regarding the progress of various pilot projects currently being conducted on campus related to retention and assessment. Dean Strong responded to questions about the proposed assessment plan required by the North Central Association for accreditation, emphasizing that the primary goal of Moorhead's assessment program is to initiate projects that will be of benefit to the university.

Motion to approve (Moore/Bakke) carried unanimously.

The Minnesota Transfer Curriculum.

Midgarden and Gracyk reviewed the history and responded to questions. Academic Affairs Vice Chancellor Manuel Lopez from the State University Board office will be on campus October 22 to meet with various groups. Academic Affairs is arranging his schedule to include students, the Liberal Studies Committee, APAC, the Faculty Association Executive Council, the Academic Affairs Council, and a session open to all others interested. Lopez's schedule will be distributed when completed.
