APAC Minutes (February 15, 1994)

Present: Barden, Chair; Bense, Crockett, Frederick, Moore, Olday Peil, Pratt, Roy, Schobel, Swenson, Wasson

Master of Science - Reading.

Roy moved, Olday seconded to approve the following changes in the Master of Science, Reading Instruction Program:

- a. Require two years of prior experience as a reading teacher for program admission.
- b. Replace ELEC 447(g), Reading Conference (1) with ELEC 523, Special Topics in Literature for Young Readers (3) in the program core.
- c. Add Ed 482(g), <u>Information Technology for Teachers</u> (3) to the list of suggested program electives.

Motion carried unanimously.

#### 2. Art.

Schobel moved, Moore seconded to approve the request for graduate designation for Art 408/408(g), <u>Women in Art</u> (4). Also approved was a prerequisite change for students who enroll in Art 408(g) which has been underlined in what follows for clarity: <u>Permission of instructor</u>. Recommended coursework would include one course in art appreciation, art history, philosophy of the arts, or women's studies.

Motion carried unanimously.

#### 3. Industrial Studies.

Moore moved, Olday seconded to approve the request for graduate designation for IndS 482/482(g), <u>Quality Planning and Implementation</u> (4).

Motion carried unanimously

#### 4. Advising Committee.

Moore moved, Swenson seconded to approve the following policy change:

The following statement will appear on the course schedule: It is recommended that students consult their advisors during the first three days of the quarter if changes are being made in the major or in related area requirements with regard to adding or dropping courses. But, an advisor's signature will not be required.

Motion carried unanimously.
