1. Liberal Studies Recommendations

2. Semester Conversion: Department of Art

Major Changes - New Courses:

Art 233/234: History of Art I, II (4/4 semester cr.)
The Art department will convert these 4 credit quarter courses to 3 credit semester courses so a new course proposal is not needed.

ART 630: Research Methods in Art Education (3 semester cr.)
Boe moved. Bakke seconded to approve.
This course was approved by the Teacher Preparation and Graduate Studies Committees.

Motion carried with one opposed.

ART 438/538: Non-Western Art (3 semester cr.)
Allen Sheets, Art Department Chair, submitted a memo requesting the course number be changed to:

Art 338: Non-Western Art (3 semester cr.)

The Liberal Studies Committee has approved this course for Division F designation. The course will no longer carry graduate designation. The course was converted from a 4 credit quarter course to a 3 credit semester course so a new course proposal is not needed.

Major Changes - Other:

Boe moved. Pemble seconded to approve the major changes as listed under Section III of the Analysis form. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the Master of Science and Specialist in School Psychology's Semester Conversion Package:

Boe moved. Moore seconded to approve the Master of Science and Specialist in School Psychology's converted semester package. Motion carried unanimously.

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5. Semester Conversion: Department of Sociology, Anthropology & Criminal Justice

The committee discussed the course offerings and the variable credit option in writing or recitation before acting on the conversion package. The committee's concern was mainly with the variable credit option the department is proposing in their conversion package. The committee felt this subject should be discussed and debated on an individual basis outside of an APAC meeting before action could be taken on the package.

Roy moved to table Sociology, Anthropology & Criminal Justice's Semester Conversion Package until members had an opportunity to discuss those issues with that department. Correnti seconded. Motion to table carried with nine approvals, five opposed and one abstention.

6. Criminal Justice Majors - Law Enforcement Program

Correnti moved. Bakke seconded to approve the following waiver:

Waive the graduation requirement that 8 of the last 12 credits be taken at MSU for all Criminal Justice majors who undertake law enforcement training.

Motion carried unanimously.
