Argument of the Play

A Duke of France, being dispossessed of his dominions by his younger brother, Frederick, retires to the neighboring forest of Arden, with a few of his faithful followers. His daughter, Rosalind, remains at the usurper's court as companion for her beloved cousin, Celia. At a wrestling match between Orlando du Bois and Charles, the Duke's wrestler, Rosalind falls in love with Orlando, the winner. Oliver du Bois hates his younger brother, Orlando, and plots to kill him. The plot is revealed to Orlando by Adam, a faithful servant, and they both flee.

The Duke Frederick, becoming jealous of Rosalind's popularity, banishes her from court; but Celia, with Touchstone, the court fool, accompanies her into exile. Rosalind disguises herself as a boy, and Celia as a shepherd girl, and they start out to find the banished Duke, Rosalind's father.

After a hard journey they reach Arden and buy a shepherd's cottage. Orlando has also come to Arden and they meet, but he does not recognize them; neither does Rosalind's father. Rosalind tests Orlando's love and finally reveals herself to them all and the comedy ends "As You Like It."
