Instructions for creating an account and submitted materials

1. Go to RED's Student Academic Conference page: <https://red.mnstate.edu/sac/>
2. On the lower left side, find "Submit Materials" and click on "Submit Presentation or Poster"
3. Create an account; make sure to use your mnstate e-mail address. You will receive an email to confirm your free account with RED
4. Read and agree to the terms
5. Fill out required information for your submission
 - a. **Event Title** (*required*)
 - b. **Presenter Information** (*required*)
 - c. **Document Type**, select one:
 - i. Poster
 - ii. Presentation
 - iii. Panel Discussion
 - d. **Disciplines**. Select all that apply (*optional*)
 - e. **Description**. Enter a brief description of your poster or presentation (*optional*)
 - f. **Comments**. Enter any additional information (*optional*)
 - g. **Full Text of Presentation**. Upload or link to a copy of your poster or presentation (*required*)
 - h. **Streaming Media**. Enter the link for your streaming audio or video file (*optional*)
6. Click "Submit"
